General Comments								
The Quality Assurance Monitor was on site to conduct a monitoring inspection. The child-to-staff ratio was consistently maintained throughout the visit. During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor verified the following: -Outdoor play area materials and equipment -Child guidance practices								

While on site, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed all children initially engaged in a ring toss activity, experimenting with how high they could throw the rings. The children later transitioned to sand play, where they built sandcastles, made sand cakes, and created sand ice cream.

During the visit, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the operator had placed a potty outside. Upon inquiry, the operator explained that the potty is used for emergencies when children are unable to reach the indoor washroom in time. The Quality Assurance Monitor expressed concerns regarding hygiene, noting that there is no sink with hot running water and soap available outdoors, as required by Public Health. Additionally, it was emphasized that potties must be cleaned thoroughly after each use to maintain sanitary conditions.

A discussion also took place regarding professional learning hours. The Quality Assurance Monitor inquired whether the operator was on track to complete the required 10 hours of professional learning for the renewal year. The operator confirmed that a course had been completed in January. The Quality Assurance Monitor clarified that professional learning hours must be completed within the renewal year—specifically from April 1, 2025, to March 31, 2026. The operator shared that they had believed the hours were counted from January to January, but stated they would verify available courses to ensure compliance.
