Purposeful planning is evident through documentation displayed throughout the environments and on the planning sheets. Documentation supports the current interests of the children (animals, cars, colors, dinosaurs, worms, and bugs).

Pasta, sweet and sour chicken and vegetables with milk to drink was served for lunch. Crackers and cantaloupe were served for afternoon snack.

Hand washing routines observed before meals, after outdoor play, during washroom and diapering routines. Diaper changing procedures were observed to be followed.

Monthly fire drills are documented.
