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<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including music and movement, dramatic play, sensory opportunities and exploring their learning environments. The infants were observed climbing on a small climbing structure and cooking in their dramatic play kitchen. Educators were observed giving the infants the choice to be lifted or use the small stairs to have their diaper changed on the changing table. The children in the Twos Room were observed during transitions to lunch time. Educators sat with the children after hand washing and sang songs as they waited for lunch to arrive. Small utensils were provided for the children to serve their own pizza and a measuring cup for them to pour their own milk. The children in the Fours Room were observed tending to their Worm Farm; they made sure the soil was damp and that they had vegetables to eat.</p> <p>Purposeful planning is evident through documentation, invitations and materials added to the environments to support the children's current interests (sensory play, bugs, babies, dumping, animals, food, mud, rocks and worms). Photos of the children are displayed throughout the childcare site.</p> <p>The outdoor play area is set-up with a variety of materials for the children to explore loose parts and engage in gross motor play.</p> <p>Pizza and milk were served for lunch. Grapes and Goldfish crackers were served for afternoon snack. Handwashing routines were observed after outdoor play, during diapering/washroom routines and before mealtimes.</p> <p>Monthly fire drills are documented.</p> <p>Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection.</p> <p>New staff file (3) review was completed; all required documents are in place.</p> <p>Incident logs are complete and signed by parent/guardians.</p> <p>Facility is currently meeting the 50% trained Early Childhood Educators (4/8) requirement.</p>
