Examples of materials to include, but are not limited to: variety of paper in colours, textures and sizes, paint, paint brushes, paint rollers, mark making materials, glue, tape, feathers, tissue paper, cardboard tubes, fabric, yarn, ribbon, recycled items, items collected from nature, collage materials, etc.

<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning/afternoon including outdoor play, gross motor play, stories and fine motor activities.</p> <p>Nap time was observed today. The environments are dim, and educators put soft music on to ensure the environment is relaxing for children. The children's cots are set-up with bedding and are situated at an adequate distance apart. Educators observed comforting children as they settle in for nap. A small group of children who do not nap from the Three/Four Room were observed engaging in gross motor play in a breakout space set-up at the end of the hallway.</p> <p>Chicken noodle soup, ham sandwiches and milk were served for lunch. Crackers and cantaloupe were served for afternoon snack.</p> <p>Handwashing routines observed after outdoor play and before meals.</p> <p>Monthly fire drills are documented.</p> <p>New staff file (4) review was completed, all required documents in place.</p>
