Purposeful planning is evident through documentation displayed throughout the environments and on the planning sheets. Documentation supports the current interests of the children (airplanes, books, clouds, babies and food).

Pasta, sweet and sour chicken and vegetables with milk to drink was served for lunch. Crackers and cantaloupe were served for afternoon snack. Children were observed serving their meals independently with encouragement from their educators.

Hand washing routines observed before meals, after outdoor play, and during washroom routines.

Monthly fire drills are documented.
