Monitoring Inspection:

Children and educators observed during indoor play, lunch time, transitions and nap time. Documentation is displayed throughout the environments that supports the current interests (books, cars, puppies, construction and outdoor play) of the children and learning experiences. Age-appropriate loose parts have been added to each room for the children to explore.

Nap time was observed today. Educators put on relaxing music and dimmed the lights. Children are comforted by educators during rest time.

Daily information sheets are completed for each child Monthly fire drills are documented. Handwashing routines observed. New staff file (4) review was completed.
