General Comments

Upon arriving at the facility, the children were finishing up their school day. An educator was observed preparing invitations to play for the children while another educator was observed standing in the hallway greeting the children as they entered the classroom. The children washed their hands and sat down on a large carpet in front of a whiteboard. An educator took attendance and asked each child what invitation they wanted to start with. After, the children were observed making Christmas ornaments, Christmas cards, making "bugs" out of playdough, pipe cleaners and eyes while some others played board games and made bracelets.

The educators were observed engaging in the children's activities by offering more materials and creating Christmas cards with the children. As some children were hungry, an educator encouraged them to eat their afternoon snack. Later, an educator was heard using active listening techniques to get the children's attention. The educator asked the children if they wanted to listen to Christmas music, as they agreed, she put on some music. As the older children arrived from school, an educator was heard communicating the child to staff ratio with the other educator. The older children washed their hands and were observed engaging in the activities with the younger children.

The indoor environment was clean and well organized. Various play materials including loose parts, craft materials, age-appropriate books, Lego, building blocks and dramatic play materials were available on low accessible shelving. The children's personal belongings were properly stored, and the washrooms were clean. Five child profiles were verified and found to be complete.
