| The operator had music playing as children were arriving this morning. Children were engaged in play throughout the room. The children enjoyed playing with the food and animals. Containers were available with water, rice, and oatmeal that held rocks, animals and toys that the children could shake and discover, Real containers and boxes allowed the children to fill and play with. The operator was kind with the children and gave reminders for please and thank you. She was observant of children and redirected them when needed. She sat to read a book asking them to repeat the letters, animals and touch the pages when they began to lose interest. She set out a sensory bucket with flour and items to pour, spoon, and mold. An additional bucket was full of natural items such as rocks and acorns with small animals for counting and putting in flour. The children really enjoyed this play and kept coming back to it. When interest was waning, the operator cleaned up and washed everyone's hands and set out a box and crayons for marking. The operator sang different songs throughout the morning using the children's names, counting, and names of items in the environment. The operator repeats words often and describes play encouraging children's language. The nap room is set up with children's cots and there is a crib in the space with some items stored. No child is in a crib right now so the quality assurance monitor recommended removing the crib for additional space and removal of storage. The washroom is easily accessible with the diaper changing area set up for individual children. | | | | | | |
