Comments: The inspector observed in 3 classrooms that no documentation was available to provide to the inspector of the daily activities. The administrator must ensure that documentation and planification are conducted.			
27 An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility before doing any of the following: (f) permitting the child to participate in an outing.	27(f)	Sep 05, 2025	
Comments: The inspector is made aware that children are going on outings after seeing the walking consent. The inspector and administrators had a discussion regarding outings. The administrator must ensure that a consent is conducted when children are stopping at a facility or park while walking to the outings.			
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies;	39(2)(a)	Aug 13, 2025	Aug 13, 2025
Comments: In one classroom, the inspector observed an OFF Insect Repellent spray bottle located on a top shelf and out of reach for children. However, all chemicals' products must be locked by a key. While on site, the administrator locked the product. Deficiency is now compliant.			
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (b) medications.	39(2)(b)	Aug 13, 2025	Aug 13, 2025
Comments: The inspector observed that the medication is kept inside a cabinet in the kitchen. At the time, the kitchen was not locked. While on site, the administrator has put the medication inside a locked box. Deficiency is now compliant.			

General Comments

The inspector observed children playing freely inside and outside. I have observed an educator playing an Alphabet game with her group and another group is painting.
Lights were down and soft music was playing during nap time.

The inspector had a discussion with the administrators regarding the Operator's Portal and qualifications.
The administrator stated that no medication was given to children in the past year.

General Comments

The facility is closed starting next week for vacation and cleaning. An application for changes must be submitted to the Quality Assurance Monitor if they plan to change the office into a sensory room.

The administrator must ensure that all staff files are completed with all the necessary documentation and in compliance with the Act.

Some staff members have not fully completed their 10 professional learning hours. They have until the renewal period, september 30th to complete them.

The ratio is respected during the inspection.
