General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor (QAM) was on site to verify the outdoor playground. A temporary fence had been installed to ensure the safety of the children during ongoing construction.

During the visit, it was observed that there were tripping hazards present due to a fence foot pedal and a tarp that had been put in place. It was recommended that the tarp either be removed or adjusted so that it no longer touches the ground in a way that creates a hazard. Additionally, it was recommended that foam protection be added to the foot pedals to prevent potential injuries to children. It was also discussed that a staff member should always be present at the temporary fence to maintain the safety and supervision of the children in proximity to the construction area.

A discussion was held between the directors, the QAM, and the Manager regarding the infant outdoor space. It was observed that the area currently has only one surface. The administrator explained that an additional sandbox had previously been available but was stored away for the fall/winter season, along with a small section of turf. It was suggested to add another surface to help reduce the impact of falls and minimize minor injuries.

The QAM discussed with the administrator that in the infant room a child was found sleeping in a swing chair. The educators must never place a sleeping child in a swing chair, as this poses a significant safety risk, including potential breathing difficulties. The educator promptly moved the child to a crib for their nap.

During the visit, it was brought to the attention of the Quality Assurance Monitor that a new educator had recently started at the facility. Upon reviewing the staff file, the QAM observed that the First Aid certification, job description, and signed declaration for the Acts and Regulations were missing. The administrator promptly retrieved the missing First Aid Certificate and job description and added it to her file. The signed declaration will be provided to the QAM once the educator returns for their next scheduled shift.

The Quality Assurance Monitor observed the children transitioning from an outdoor walk to lunchtime, followed by their transition to nap time.
