<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>A monitoring inspection occurred today, April 23, 2026. Children were observed in their indoor environment actively engaging with a variety of learning invitations. One invitation included a drawing created by the operator, which the children recreated using their own chalk and paper. This activity demonstrated both creativity and the children's interest in replicating and expanding on adult-modeled ideas.</p> <p>Children were also observed tending to seeds they had planted. The group is currently growing cucumbers, tomatoes, squash, and sunflowers inside a designated growing tent. This long-term project supports responsibility, scientific inquiry, and ongoing observation as the children monitor the growth of their plants.</p> <p>A special visitor, "Milton," a puppy, was present in the environment. The children were gentle, attentive, and highly engaged with the puppy, demonstrating empathy and care while interacting with him. This experience contributed to social-emotional learning and provided a calming presence in the room.</p> <p>Open-ended art was displayed throughout the environment, showcasing the children's creativity and the educators' commitment to offering materials that support exploration and self-expression. A cozy corner was set up with soft furnishings, providing a comfortable space for children to relax and read the books available.</p> <p>For snack time, children were offered apples, goldfish crackers, granola bars, and veggie straws. Operator put on a clean up song before the children went outside to play before pick up.</p> <p>Attendance was completed accurately and was up to date at the time of inspection. The parent board was also reviewed and found to be complete. It included renewal reports, monitoring documentation, licensing information, and the operator's first aid certification. This ensured that families had access to all required and relevant information.</p>
