## **General Comments**

A monitoring inspection occurred on one infant room, the two preschool rooms and the school-age room. The second infant room, ratio was taken but Inspector did not enter the room as some children were sleeping during the inspection, and others were awakening from their nap.

Mandatory attendance records, ratio, incident logs, daily information sheets, required postings, planning in the childcare rooms, medication records, and four new staff files were reviewed and verified complete.

Infant 1 room, Inspector observed that documentation supporting the children's learning is displayed on the walls. Pictures and stories of the children reading books, stacking rings, playing dress up, exploring painting with instruments were all observed. Children were also observed waking up from nap, going for a nap, having snack and outside play in the fenced play area.

Jr Pre K room, the children's learning is documented and displayed, pictures of the children's art, playing with dolls and bathing them, educators reading and singing with children, family portraits made from playdough, google eyes and pipe cleaner. Creating art with apples. Children were observed by the Inspector playing in the dramatic play kitchen area, playing trucks, having afternoon snack and preparing to go for a neighborhood walk.

In the preschool room, Inspector observed the children and educators playing with magnets and jingle bells and discovering how the magnets can attract and move the bells across the tuff tray. Children's art and learning was observed displayed on the walls. Samples of the art pictures made from natural materials found outside, pictures of creating art by rolling acorns, a Halloween walk in the neighborhood and making playdough pies. Educators indicated that the children have written a letter to Santa. Children were also observed having afternoon snack and preparing to go outside.

In the school-age room, Inspector observed the children arriving from school and preparing for afternoon snack. Children were also observed drawing elves. Documentation on the walls and in a binder depict the children's current and past learning. Documentation of exploring pumpkin volcanos, a calendar of planning was observed displayed. Inspector observed a variety of board games, blocks, art materials, dramatic play, and air hockey in
