General Comments

When licensing staff arrived, children were finishing up snack in the infant room to go outside. Educators have been adding to their rooms in this new addition with children's crafts and learning stories. Educators had created laminated family photo sheets with the children's names and their family photos on them. They located the sheets accessible to children on a shelf and the educator mentioned they are favored by the children. The educators are still working to get labels on all the shelves and were encouraged to take a photo of what is presently on the shelf and use this as a label with the name as a suggestion.

Learning stories show evidence of educators supporting and documenting the children's learning. Licensing staff encouraged educators to include next steps on documentation and provide additional documentation when the next step occurred. One educator remarked that they had collected seeds as shown in the learning story and they were thinking about what to do next, so this provided the opportunity to do that. Licensing staff reminded educators that they can show their own learning and research within documentation as evidence of

pre-planning and their learning with and from children. Children's photos and names can also be added in several areas of the space to support children's literate identities.

The children all went outside this morning with some children going on a walk in the area. The outdoor play space had a variety of materials and sand was being added to all the sandboxes over the noon hour. A permanent gazebo covering has been added in the infant area and will be included in each of the outdoor play areas to provide a shaded area throughout the year.

New staff files were reviewed and were complete and organized. The administrator commented on the educators keeping up on their PL hours. Educators were observed counting children when leaving the outdoor play area to ensure all children are present.
