General Comments

- -Morning visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection
- -During the visit, ratio child-to-staff is maintained and respected in same age and mixed age groups
- -The administrator as well as all educators have a valid first aid certificate
- -Monthly emergency evacuation and fire drills are completed
- -Children and staff daily attendance are maintained on site
- -Daily incident log is maintained, parents are advised and signs the daily log
- -Incident report forms are completed and signed by the parent when in need to fill a reportable incident. The report is sent to the Department within 24 hours following the incident and a copy is given to the parent.
- -Incident reports are maintained in the child's file
- -Daily routine into the center includes; Outdoor play time at least once every 4 hour blocks time when the weather is permitting. Meal and snacks are served at the recognized hours and a daily rest period that meets the children's needs.
- -Toxic products, and cleaning supplies are locked under key and are inaccessible to children
- -Each child has an easily accessible space to store their personal belongings, which is labeled with their name and used only for the intended child.
- -Pacifiers do not have a neck string
- -It was observed during the visit that children are guided on how to express their feeling and use words when being hurt, angry, frustrated, sad...and the other part involved being shown how to listen and repair their actions.
- -During the visit, it was observed that all educators are engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations.
- -Snow surrounding both gateways leading to the two outside fenced in space are well cleaning, both doors open and closes easily.

Observations: When arriving at the center infants are outside playing in the fenced-in space, all the others followed shortly. The three's and fours were playing out back on a snow hill, sliding and rolling. When everybody came in some groups got a short period of free play, then ate lunch and got ready for pap time.
