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General Comments
-Early-morning visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection -Ratio was respected during the visit -The administrator as well as all educators have a valid first aid certificate -New employees are registered for their 90h-Introduction to early childhood, their training will start during fall 2026 -The administrator and more than 50% of the staff have their one-year Early childhood education certificate -When acetaminophen is administered to a child, the consent form is signed by the parent and kept into the children file. -Medication are locked and stored in the cleaning supplies closet next to the bathroom downstairs. -During the visit, it was observed that all educators are engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations. Open-end questions are asked and guidance is given in a respectful and kind way. -Each child has an easily accessible space to store their personal belongings, which is labeled with their name and used only for the intended child. -Outdoor material is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present and consists of more than one surface to permit different types of play. -Outdoor play area is maintained safe and free of hazards -The outdoor play area has at least 0.45m² of shade for each child based on the maximum number of children that can be accommodated in the outdoor play area -Infant outdoor play area is separate from preschool and school age children -The staff are into their summer challenge; the administrator gave her staff a challenge to create opportunities for children to explore with digital literacy and natural material during the summer break -In all rooms, evidence of purposeful planning based on children's interest and learning, photos and learning stories were posted. Observations: When arriving at the center all children were eating their snack once they were done eating; sunscreen was put on and they all got ready to go to either play outside or go for a walk.
