### General Comments

- Late Afternoon visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection
- Ratio was respected during the visit
- Posted when entering the room on the left-hand side are the following documents: The license, inspection report, orders for compliance, daily routine, evacuation procedures, name of administrator, name and telephone number of QA Monitor and inspector - Life threatening allergies
- When it applies a notice to inform parents of the existence of a communicable disease is posted on the room door.
- The following administrative records are maintained on site: Daily attendance of children and staff, monthly emergency evacuation fire drills
- Monthly emergency evacuation and fire drills are completed
- Exemption form request has been sent to the operator for any changes made to this regulation
- A monthly review and maintenance plan is completed on all stationary equipment
- During the visit, it was observed that all educators are engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations. Open-end questions are asked and guidance is given in a respectful and kind way
- Children's indoor play area is safe and clean.
- Material and equipment proposed to children in the indoor play area are easily accessible on low, open shelves. It is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present.
- All children's files have consent forms that are signed and dated by a parent/guardian
- All staff records contain required checks and documentation
- New communicable disease posters from public health were given

Observations: When arriving at the center, staff were downstairs at the cafeteria greeting the children, once everybody has arrived, they all made their way to their designated room. Half of the children ate snack and the other half started working on their bracelets. Once snack was done different stations were set up, ex: cup stacking, coloring, table-top games and blocs.
