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General Comments Licensing Staff arrived at Little Darlings Daycare to conduct the Renewal Inspection. Upon arrival the children were in the process of lining up to go play outside. All children used the washroom before transitioning to the outdoor play area. Hats and water bottles were brought outside with the group. The outdoor environment offered a wide variety of play materials such as a mud kitchen, sandbox, chalkboard, cars, balls, trucks and a large play structure with multiple swings and slides. The children were observed making pancakes, muffins and ice cream in the sandbox area. Afterwards, the children created a shop in the playhouse to sell the items they made in the sandbox. The Operator was observed blowing bubbles for the children and pushing them on the swings throughout the morning. A gentle reminder was heard before the group transitioned inside to prepare for lunch time. Once inside the children used the washroom and hands were washed before they sat together for lunch time. As the children finished eating, they had some free play in the main playroom before settling down for nap time. In the nap room curtains were shut and a sound machine was turned on. The children who did not nap played quietly in the playroom. Staff and child profiles were reviewed and contained all required documents. The Operator uses weekly planning sheets to track the interest of the children and plan activities around this. The Operator spoke calmly and respectfully when interacting with the children. The Operator was heard supporting the children during a disagreement, acknowledging their feelings and helping find a solution. Licensing Staff recommends for Renewal.
