Comments: At least 50% of educators do not hold an Early Childhood Education Certificate or training that is equivalent. A written plan was submitted to the Quality Assurance Monitor explaining how this deficiency will be compliant.			

General Comments
The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site in the morning to conduct a monitoring inspection. The child-to-staff ratio was respected during the inspection. The following elements were verified: - Daily routine - Daily routine - Indoor play area and equipment - Washrooms - Storage space - Diaper changing - If all required documents are posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility A discussion was held with the administrator regarding the Daily activities planning. The Quality Assurance monitor observed that in two classrooms the daily activity planning book was left at the educator's home. A reminder was made to the educator to always have the daily activity book at the facility. The Quality Assurance Monitor observed learning stories on the wall and pictures with documentation of the recent activities from the past weeks.

General Comments

During the inspection the Quality Assurance Monitor observed the children playing in the outdoor play area and playing with bubbles. The children were also observed playing in the indoor play area with magnetic tiles, drawing, playing imaginary doctor play. One classroom was engaged in painting with spray bottles that were created with dried markers and water. The children sprayed the paint on paper and were creating their own painting. The Quality Assurance monitor also observed the children transitioning to the indoor play area to eat their lunch (lunch boxes). Positive interactions were observed between the educators and the children.
