Comments: Some of the children's files were missing immunization records. Please request these from parent(s). If they cannot be provided a immunization waiver must be signed.

Comments: The measured space that the facility was originally approved for in the 3 year old room is not being used. It is being used to store bedding for the children. This area required materials for the children. Bedding needs to be stored elsewhere as discussed.			
30(3) An operator shall maintain the indoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	30(3)	Jan 26, 2026	
Comments: Please ensure shelving in classrooms remain free from clutter. The infant sleep room must not be used as storage.

Comments: Many of the classrooms require more materials. The materials should support learning centres and as defined in the New Brunswick Curriculum Framework.

Comments: More shelving will be required to store materials and to create more learning centres in the classrooms

Comments: The infants bedding was not being stored properly. They were hanging over the cots in the crib sleeping area. The bedding in the 3 year old class was stored in cubbies close to the floor and some of the blankets were touching the floor. Please ensure that bedding is labelled and stored separately for each child.			
47(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall refuse admission to a child if satisfactory proof of the immunizations required by the Public Health Act or the regulations under that Act is not provided.	47(1)	Jan 26, 2026	
Comments: Immunization records or a waiver for infant and preschool children are required prior to the child's entry.			

General Comments
<p>Licensing staff discussed pre-planned programming with both the educators and the administrator. Through conversations with the educators, they were able to articulate how their activities are based off of the children's interests however the connection between the children's interests, the planning sheets that the educator's are using, and the visible documentation is not clear.</p> <p>Educators should start using a method to pre-plan their program such as webbing or journaling to help demonstrate that planning is a process that involves engaging the children and reflecting on their interests, passions, strengths and abilities. Licensing staff advised the administrator to reach out to their curriculum consultant for best practices in this area.</p> <p>Learning stories, photos of the children, and the children's artwork are some of the methods that the educators are using for documentation.</p> <p>Attendance records, infant toddler sheets, medication records, incident records, fire drill records, child files and staff files were organized and easily verified by licensing staff. Potential illness forms and return after exclusion forms are being used as necessary.</p> <p>The educators were engaged with the children. They were observed at the children's level, having conversations with them and comforting them as needed. They redirected more challenging behaviours and used a guidance that was direct but gentle.</p> <p>It is recommended that chairs with backs be used in the 2 year old room. It is also recommended that a table be added to the infant space so that older infants can transition from the high chairs to a table.</p> <p>Please ensure that there is sufficient spacing between the high chairs when the children are eating.</p>
