General Comments
<p>The purpose of this visit was to conduct a follow-up inspection.</p> <p>-The three year old room now has more resources and shelving for learning. The area that was being used as storage has been transformed into 2 learning areas with an abundance of materials. The children appeared engaged and the layout of the classroom appears to be working for the children.</p> <p>-The educators have made the space where the cots are stored inaccessible to the children as they could not lay the cots flat due to spacing. Bedding is now being stored separately in labelled bags.</p> <p>-Please continue to monitor clutter throughout the centre especially in the infant sleep room. Permission was granted to store high chairs in the corner by the window in the sleep room; however the area needs to remain clutter free. The educators personal belongings cannot be stored here. The administrator stated that hooks are being purchased to install in the hallway for the children's belongings. Personal belongings cannot be stored on the floor in hallways at any time.</p> <p>The teacher cupboards are a great addition in the classrooms to reduce clutter on top of shelving in the classroom.</p> <p>Chairs with backs have been added in the two year old room. The educators stated that this is working much better.</p> <p>Child files are now complete with immunization records.</p> <p>I can now recommend facility for licensing pending a current Fire and Health inspection.</p>
