Children and educators observed engaged in variety of activities this afternoon including open-ended art, fine motor activities, dramatic play, and painting opportunities. Educators observed engaging in meaningful conversations with children at their level.							
Purposeful planning is evident through planning documented on planning sheets; documentation displayed throughout the learning environment and invitation set-up for the children to explore when they arrive from school.							
QA Monitor discussed fire evacuation procedures and floor plan drawing with staff during inspection. The escape route is not documented on the posted floor plans. Ensure route is added. A copy of the floor plan drawing and the written procedures must be posted at each exit within the facility.
