A renewal inspection occurred July 17, 2025.

Children spent the majority of the time during the inspection in the outdoor wooded area adjacent to the childcare facility.

All staff files we reviewed and were verified complete except for the incorrect First Aid training in two files.

In the wooded area, the children were observed swinging in hammocks, creating houses with cardboard boxes, coloring, climbing rocks, and having snack/lunch. Inspector also observed that the educators had taken board games and books to this area for the children to interact and engage with.
