<p>A renewal inspection occurred July 17, 2025.</p> <p>Children spent the majority of the time during the inspection in the outdoor wooded area adjacent to the childcare facility.</p> <p>All staff files we reviewed and were verified complete except for the incorrect First Aid training in two files.</p> <p>In the wooded area, the children were observed swinging in hammocks, creating houses with cardboard boxes, coloring, climbing rocks, and having snack/lunch. Inspector also observed that the educators had taken board games and books to this area for the children to interact and engage with.</p> <p>Inspector observed in the indoor play area age-appropriate materials for the children, science materials such as</p>

magnets, scales, weights were observed. Pictures of the children engaged in activities both inside and out were observed displayed on the walls.

A tour of the facilities greenhouse occurred, and Inspector observed different types of vegetables being grown by the children at the facility.
