| A monitoring inspection was conducted in the afternoon of February 10, 2026. |
| The children were observed in both the indoor and outdoor environments, including during transitions between the two. Additionally, the children were also observed eating snack, with handwashing occurring beforehand. |
| Indoors, the children were observed playing dominoes alongside their educator, building with LEGO, making Valentine's Day cards at the table with their educator, building with brick blocks, and engaging in dramatic play. |
| Outdoors, the children were observed sliding down the hill, climbing on the large tires, and building a fort using sticks, logs, and branches. |
| The educators indicated that the children are currently interested in art, role play, particularly pretending to be teachers and students, board games, and making their own crayons using the crayon maker available in the classroom. |
| Several forms of documentation were visible, including photographs, and children's artwork. The room was well organized and inviting, offering a variety of appropriate materials, books, and toys. |
| The educators demonstrated positive interactions with children by using encouraging language and gentle reminders. The educators asked open ended questions, listened actively, and extended children's ideas through conversation. |
| A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for posting the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documentation observed included incident logs, daily attendance records, one staff file, and monthly emergency evacuation and fire drill records. |
