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General Comments A Monitoring Inspection was conducted this afternoon. The School Aged children were observed entering the After School Program. Children were observed hanging up their bookbags, washing their hands, and choosing an activity to take part in. Children were observed building Lego, practicing their printing / spelling on writing tablets, painting, playing dress up, and playing with Barbies. Parent Board was observed and all required documentation was posted. Positive child guidance techniques were observed - educators offering choices, educators conversing with the children, and educators providing appropriate supervision. A conversation was had with Administrator regarding EpiPens. As stated on page 81 of the Operator's Manual, EpiPens are the only medication that can be easily accessible to staff members and are not required to be locked, however they are not to be accessible to children. It is recommended that all EpiPens be kept out of reach of children. A conversation was had with Administrator regarding the outside play area and pea gravel. Administrator stated that educators and children often need to rake certain areas of pea gravel, to make it safer for certain pieces of equipment. It is recommended that pea gravel be added to the outdoor play area. Because the playground belongs to the school / district, Quality Assurance Monitor will reach out to the district to see if this is a possibility.
