| Upon the arrival of licensing staff, educators were observed waiting in the school cafeteria for the school-age children to arrive. A head count was completed, and the group proceeded to the gym. Once in the gym, the children sat in a circle while educators positively reminded them to put on their indoor shoes. One educator engaged the group in a "Can You Hear Me?" game and reviewed the Go-Go values in an interactive manner, while another set up activity materials. Due to outdoor temperatures exceeding 35°C, a decision was made to remain indoors for the afternoon. Children were given the option to eat their snack at the tables or engage in free play. Activities observed included playing with blocks, relaxing in a designated "calming corner," using dinosaur figures, drawing, and exploring books. Additional materials available included a dramatic play kitchen, toy cars, and dolls. The open gym environment allowed children ample space to move about freely. An easel displayed the required parent board information, and staff and child files were found to follow regulations. Positive child guidance was observed throughout the inspection.
