<p>General Comments</p> <p>When Licensing staff arrived at the school the afterschool had just gone outside to play. Two educators were present and were well spaced to keep proper supervision of the children at all times. The children were well aware of the rules of the program and their boundaries for the school playground and only a few gentle reminders were necessary. A group of boys played soccer with a ball and another group played an imaginary game that they invented under the main play structure. One of the educators was subbing for the regular educator and the other educator was new to the program. Staff were aware of how the program should function and used pro-active child guidance to manage the transitions and children's behaviours when they tested the directions of their new teachers. When a child refused to come indoors the educator was able to talk him into coming in.</p> <p>Once in the gym that the group uses for a classroom, it took them a few minutes to set up stations for play, but when it was completed, there were lots of variety for the children and everyone found something interesting to do. An educator played wordle with one child, and the other helped with the crafts and colouring at another table. This left the rest of the gym for more games with balls, space for four squares and soccer. There were also couple of bean bags and books set up for reading and relaxing.</p> <p>The Go Go Parent Board and postings were brought out and had been updated for the new Quality Assurance Monitor. The staff and child files were reviewed and they were all up to date. The gym was clean and organized and the program has storage for its materials. This is very helpful because the program needs to be set up and taken down daily and the supplies locked up in storage.</p> <p>The educators were very kind and patient with the children. They helped mediate disputes and comfort them when there were hurt feelings or small bumps etc. The educators were engaged in the children's play and genuinely interested in their conversations. The children used their indoor voices, and the noise volume was good, especially considering how much sound bounces and echoes in a gym.</p>
